The contest will work as follows. Using the wager sheet, mark who you think will win each individual proposition. Each proposition has a different payoff. Example: \#27 "First Score is a Touchdown" If you wager that the first score is a touchdown, you can you can lose $\$ 140$ or win $\$ 100$. If you wage the first score is not a touchdown you can lose $\$ 100$ or win $\$ 110$. For wagers with odds (i.e., 12-1), the payoff depends on the odds. 12-1 on a $\$ 100$ bet will lose $\$ 100$ and win $\$ 1,200$. 7-2 odds on a $\$ 100$ bet will lose $\$ 100$ and Win $\$ 350$. Lastly, 1-2 odds will win $\$ 100$ and lose $\$ 200$.

Each contestant will contribute $\$ 25$ and the payoffs will be as always (3rd-\$25, 2nd-\$50, 1st-the rest). Rankings will be based on the net amount won. Every bet is for $\$ 100$.
