Here is your chance to once again prove your football knowledge (or lack thereof). The rules are simple. Each bowl game is listed along with the point spread. For example, LSU is favored by 4.5 points over Ohio St. If you think LSU will win by 5 points or more then pick LSU. If you think LSU will win by 4 or less points or not win at all then pick Ohio St. The tiebreaker will be based on the combined score of the LSU-Ohio St. game. If you think the score will be 37 to 27 then write 64 (37 + 27) in the tie breaker box.
