## How to Win

Each box has two numbers related to it. One for Indianapolis. One for the New Orleans. If, at the end of any quarter, the numbers related to your box match the last digit of each team's score, you win. For example, if you have a box with Indianapolis - 1 and New Orleans - 7 and the halftime score is Indianapolis 21 New Orleans 7, you would win.

If the board isn't full there may be a quarter with no winner. If this happens that money will be allocated evenly to the other quarters. For example, if no one wins the first quarter then the other three quarters will be allocated one-third of the pot.
