#### Abstract

The contest will work as follows. Using the wager sheet, mark on the entry form next to the applicable question number who you think will win each individual proposition. Each proposition has a different payoff. Example: \#27 "First Score is a Touchdown" If you wager that the first score is a touchdown, you can you can lose $\$ 170$ or win $\$ 100$. If you wager the first score is not a touchdown you can lose $\$ 100$ or win $\$ 140$. For wagers with odds (i.e., 12-1), the payoff depends on the odds. 12-1 on a $\$ 100$ bet will lose $\$ 100$ and win $\$ 1,200$. $7-2$ odds on a $\$ 100$ bet will lose $\$ 100$ and Win $\$ 350$. Lastly, 1-2 odds will win $\$ 100$ and lose $\$ 200$.

Each contestant will contribute $\$ 25$ and the payoffs will be (5th-\$25, 4th-\$25, 3rd-15\%, $2 \mathrm{nd}-25 \%, 1 \mathrm{st}-60 \%$ ). Rankings will be based on the net amount won. Every bet is for $\$ 100$.
