The contest will work as follows. Using the wager sheet, circle who you think will win each individual proposition. Each proposition has a different payoff. Example: #27 "First Score is a Touchdown" If you wager that the first score is a touchdown, you can you can lose \$150 or win \$100. If you wager the first score is not a touchdown you can lose \$100 or win \$130 (+130). For wagers with odds (i.e., 12-1), the payoff depends on the odds. 12-1 on a \$100 bet will lose \$100 and win \$1,200. 7-2 odds on a \$100 bet will lose \$100 and Win \$350. Lastly, 1-2 odds will win \$100 and lose \$200.

Each contestant will contribute \$25 and the payoffs will be as always (3rd-\$25, 2nd-\$50, 1st-the rest). Rankings will be based on the net amount won. Every bet is for \$100.
